The Dallas-Fort Worth area is No. 11 in Global Trade magazine's list of the Top 50 Cities for Global Trade, saying DFW is "a logistics dream."

The magazine compiled its ranking based on export volume combined with unique qualities for each city determined by Global Trade's editors.

Here's what the magazine had to say about Dallas-Fort Worth:

"From the land that brought us J.R. and the Bass Brothers, we would expect the Greater Dallas-Fort Worth area to show big. What's not to like about Dallas-Fort Worth? With superb cargo facilities at D/FW, great rail service from BNSF and access to a plethora of interstates, it's a logistics dream. Friday night lights, cowboy boots and line dancing at Billy Bob's can make for a fun weekend, too. Go Frogs!"

The [magazine said DFW's export volume](#) was \$22.5 billion and that the top trade partners were Mexico, Canada and China.

New York City was No.1 with \$85.1 billion in export volume, followed by Houston with \$80.6 billion.
