DART will trim service on Fourth of July

Dallas Area Rapid Transit will have reduced service on the Fourth of July.

DART trains and buses will operate on a Sunday schedule. Details are at DART.org.

The Trinity Railway Express will not be running between Dallas and Fort Worth.

DART Paratransit, too, will operate at what is normally its Sunday service level. The scheduling center will be closed, but customers may use X-Press or Voice Mail booking. Trips for the Fourth, which is Friday, must be booked by Wednesday, trips for Saturday must be booked by Thursday.

DART's administrative offices, customer care center and lost and found will be closed. Customers with questions about routes and schedules can call 214-979-1111 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
