## Toll connectors for LBJ, I-35E won't open this weekend after all

The new tolled bridges between Interstate 35E and LBJ Freeway won't open this weekend as expected, a spokeswoman for the project said Friday.

The developer is putting finishing touches on the project and must wait for the Texas Department of Transportation to clear it. That is expected to happen next week.

The interchanges are the second of three phases in LBJ's \$2.7 billion expansion. They will eventually connect to managed toll lanes being added to LBJ, Loop 12 and I-35E through Denton County.

The existing free interchanges between I-35E and LBJ won't be affected by the project and will remain an option.
