

Big highway projects top regional group's agenda

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The North Central Texas Council of Governments will have a meeting Thursday about several transportation projects toward which the agency is steering \$727 million in state funds.

Those projects include repairs to Interstate 345, work on State Highway 114 and extension of the southern portion of State Highway 360. The I-345 project is solely aimed at fixing the bridge east of downtown Dallas while the Texas Department of Transportation studies the cost of tearing that thoroughfare down and replacing it with a street-level boulevard.

The meeting will also focus on air quality projects and other transportation initiatives.

The meeting will be at 6:30 p.m. in the council chambers at Dallas City Hall, 1500 Marilla St.

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
