

 **Washington** - Dallas City Councilmember Vonciel Jones Hill, District 3, has been appointed to the National League of Cities (NLC) 2014 Transportation Infrastructure & Services Steering Committee. This committee has the lead responsibility for developing NLC federal policy positions on issues involving transportation, including planning, funding, safety and security of public transit, streets and highways, aviation, railroads and ports. The appointment was announced by NLC President and St. Paul MN Mayor Chris Coleman.

As a member of the committee, Councilmember Hill will play a key role in shaping NLC's policy positions and advocate on behalf of America's cities and towns before Congress, with the Administration and at home.
