Fort Worth District 6 Councilman Jungus Jordan has been named president-elect of the Texas Municipal League.

The appointment was announced Nov. 23 at the organization's 100th annual conference in Grapevine.

"I am humbled and honored to take a leadership role in TML," Jordan said in a news release.

"I recognize the critical element that cities work closest to the people, and together we stand united in this great state," Jordan said.
