TON (MarketWatch) -- The House of Representatives on Tuesday passed a bill and federal transportation funds through May 2015. The White House on Monday the \$10 billion measure, a move that increases its odds of passing the Democratate. Conservative groups have slammed the bill for using what they call gimmicks, like letting corporations contribute less to pensions, which thereby boosts the government's tax revenue. Without a deal, the Transportation Department has said it would cut back on payments to states starting in August. The House vote was 367 to 55.
